

BEING a tract or percel of land situated in the City of Enris, Ellis County, Texas, and being pert of the Claiborne Garrett Survey Abstract 383, and being Lots A, A1, B, C, D, 31 and 32 of Folleson's Addition and addition to the City of Enris as recorded in Cabinet A Slide 258 of the Map Records of Ellis County and also being that 6.9568 acre tract of land conveyed to DWX Fank Company, Inc. by deed recorded in Volume 1668 Page 812 of the Official Public Records of Ellis County, and being more particularly described as follows.

BEGINNING at a point for corner at a 5/8" iron rod found at the intersection of the northerly line of Brombeck Street and the southwesterly line of Spur 469 (formerly Old Highway 75) said point also being the southeasterly corner of said Lot 32;

THENCE South 60° 04' 05" West (deed bearing) along the northerly line of Brombeck Street a distance of 329.2 feet to a point of corner at a spike found;

THENCE South 13° 07' 09' West along the westerly line of Brombeck Street a distance of 344.71 feet to the beginning of a curve to the left at a ½" iron red found,

THENCE in a southerly direction along the westerly line of Brombeck Street and along said curve to the left baving a radius of 15-12.28 feet, a central angle of 4° 36' 38" and an arc leagth of 124.1 feet to a point for corner at a ½" iron rod found;


