

Municipal Setting Designation

As provided for in §361.807, Subchapter W, Texas Health and Safety Code (Solid Waste Disposal Act):

I, Glenn Shankle, Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality certify the Municipal Setting Designation for MSD No. 52, in the City of Fort Worth, the tract of land described in Exhibit "A". The eligibility requirements of Texas Health and Safety Code §361.803 are satisfied as attested to by the affidavit in Exhibit "B" provided pursuant to Texas Health and Safety Code §361.804(b)(2)(D). This certificate shall continue in effect so long as the institutional control required by Texas Health and Safety Code §361.8065 is maintained in effect.

Any person addressing environmental impacts for a property located in the certified municipal setting designation shall complete any necessary investigation and response action requirements in accordance with Texas Health and Safety Code §361.808, in conjunction with the applicable Texas Commission on Environmental Quality environmental remediation regulation, as modified by Texas Health and Safety Code §361.808.

THENCE departing the westerly line of said T.J.L. GRAVEL COMPANY tract and along the northerly Right-of-Way line of said CALLOWAY CEMETERY ROAD North 89 deg 42 min 44 sec West a distance of 400.00 feet to the most southwesterly corner of said LOT 1, BLOCK 1 which a 5/8 inch iron rod found bears South 82 deg 22 min 08 sec West a distance of 0.71 feet;

THENCE departing the northerly Right-of-Way line of said CALLOWAY CEMETERY ROAD South 01 deg 34 min 16 sec West a distance of 30.00 feet to a point for corner in the approximate centerline of said CALLOWAY CEMETERY ROAD;

THENCE along the approximate centerline of said CALLOWAY CEMETERY ROAD North 89 deg 42 min 44 sec West a distance of 508.30 feet to a point for corner which a Pk Nail found bears North 45 deg 35 min 56 sec West a distance of 0.90 feet;

THENCE departing the approximate centerline of said CALLOWAY CEMETERY ROAD North 00 deg 14 min 59 sec East a distance of 30.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod found for the most southeasterly corner of LOT 3, BLOCK 1 of the PETROLEUM INDUSTRIES INC. ADDITION, an addition to the City of Fort Worth as recorded in Volume 388-196, Page 64 of the Plat Records of Tarrant County, Texas (PRTCT), said point being in the northerly Right-of-Way line of said CALLOWAY CEMETERY ROAD:

THENCE along the northerly Right-of-Way line of said CALLOWAY CEMETERY ROAD North 89 deg 42 min 44 sec West a distance of 239.51 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod

found for the most southeasterly corner of LOT 4, BLOCK 1 of the PETROLEUM INDUSTRIES INC. ADDITION, an addition to the City of Fort Worth as recorded in Cabinet B, Slide 225 of the Plat Records of Tarrant County, Texas (PRTCT);

THENCE departing the northerly Right-of-Way line of said CALLOWAY CEMETERY ROAD and along the easterly line of said LOT 4, BLOCK 1 North 00 deg 18 min 38 sec East a distance of 444.90 feet to the most northeasterly corner of said LOT 4, BLOCK 1;

THENCE along the northerly line of said LOT 4, BLOCK 1 North 89 deg 42 min 44 sec West a distance of 254.27 feet to a ½ inch iron rod found for the most northwesterly corner of said LOT 4, BLOCK 1;

THENCE along the westerly line of said LOT 4, BLOCK 1 South 00 deg 12 min 20 sec West passing through a 5/8 inch iron rod found at a distance of 147.95 feet and passing through the most southwesterly corner of said LOT 4, BLOCK 1 at a distance of 444.90 feet continuing in all a distance of 474.71 feet to a point for corner in the approximate centerline of said CALLOWAY CEMETERY ROAD which a Rail Road Spike found bears North 20 deg 36 min 51 sec East a distance of 0.60 feet;

THENCE along the approximate centerline of said CALLOWAY CEMETERY ROAD North 89 deg 39 min 29 sec West a distance of 488.19 feet to a Pk Nail found for corner, said point being the most southwesterly corner of said SOUTHWEST PRODUCTS LLC tract;

THENCE departing the approximate centerline of said CALLOWAY CEMETERY ROAD and along the westerly line of said SOUTHWEST PRODUCTS LLC tract; North 00 deg 16 min 31 sec East a distance of 1124.30 feet to the most northwesterly corner of said SOUTHWEST PRODUCTS LLC tract;

THENCE departing the westerly line of said SOUTHWEST PRODUCTS LLC tract and along the northerly line of said SOUTHWEST PRODUCTS LLC tract South 89 deg 51 min 04 sec East a distance of 486.82 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod found for the most northeasterly corner of said SOUTHWEST PRODUCTS LLC tract, said point being the most northwest corner of said LOT 3, BLOCK 1;

THENCE South 89 deg 49 min 44 sec East passing through a ½ inch iron rod found for the most northeasterly corner of said LOT 3, BLOCK 1 at a distance of 493.81 feet and passing through a 3/8 inch iron rod found for the most northwesterly corner of said LOT 1, BLOCK 1 at a distance of 1028.13 feet continuing in all a distance of 1428.15 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod found for the most northeasterly corner of said LOT 1, BLOCK 1, said point being found in the westerly line of the said T.J.L. GRAVEL COMPANY tract;

THENCE along the westerly line of said T.J.L. GRAVEL COMPANY tract South 01 deg 34 min 16 sec West a distance of 1099.33 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING;

CONTAINING within these metes and bounds 46.004 acres or 2,003,943 square feet of land more or less. Bearings contained within this field note description are based upon an on the ground survey performed in the field on the 29th day of March, 2007 utilizing GPS measurements.


