

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has reviewed the "Drinking Water Survey Report" (DWSR), dated February 27, 2017, and additional information submitted via email on March 28, 2017, both prepared by ECS Texas, LLP. The DWSR stated that no private drinking water wells were found to be located within one-half mile of the subject property. Additionally, the DWSR indicates that drinking water for the site and surrounding area is provided by the City of Dallas municipal water supply.
