As a registered scrap tire generator, you are authorized to store used tires, scrap tires, and tire pieces at the above-referenced facility address provided the tire quantities do not exceed 500 used or scrap tires (or weight equivalent tire pieces or any combination thereof) on the ground or 2,000 used or scrap tires (or weight equivalent tire pieces or any combination thereof) in enclosed and lockable containers.

If you store used or scrap tires in excess of 500 used or scrap tires (or weight equivalent tire pieces or any combination thereof) on the ground or 2,000 used or scrap tires (or weight equivalent tire pieces or any combination thereof) in trailers, you are required to obtain a scrap tire storage registration pursuant to 30 TAC §328.55.
