The Industrial and Hazardous Waste (I&HW) Permits Section of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) acknowledges the receipt of Form 0525 dated July 16, 2018 submitted pursuant to the notification requirements of Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Section (§) 335.6(h) (Notification of recycling activity). We understand that Trent Wind Farm intends to recycle a waste identified by the Texas waste code number 00103192 as a feedstock/ingredient in the manufacturing of fiberglass based components.

Under Title 30 TAC §335.6, Trent Wind Farm is responsible for ensuring that the TCEQ is notified of any changes or additional information referenced in 30 TAC §335.6 including:

- 1) The description and composition of the waste;
- 2) The process by which the waste is generated; and
- 3) The manner in which the waste is managed.

Please be aware that, under Title 30 TAC §335.1(146)(I)(Definitions), respondents who raise a claim that a certain material is not a solid waste, or is exempt from regulation must demonstrate to the Executive Director that there is a known market or disposition for the material, and that they meet the terms of the exclusion or exemption. In doing so, they must provide appropriate documentation to demonstrate that the material is not a waste, or is conditionally exempt from regulation. Such documentation may include, but is not limited to, contracts showing that a second person uses the material as an ingredient in a production process<sup>1</sup>. In addition, owners and operators of facilities claiming that they actually are recycling materials must demonstrate to the Executive Director that they have the necessary equipment to do so and that the recycling activity is legitimate and beneficial.<sup>2</sup>

<sup>1</sup> This language is intended to alert Trent Wind Farm to its responsibilities if and when it should ever raise a claim of exemption.

<sup>2</sup> At this time, we are not requesting that such documentation be provided, but only pointing out that the appropriate "respondents" should create and maintain such documentation in an easily retrievable form should it ever be requested (e.g., by a TCEQ regional inspector).

Additionally, all wastes, including those that are recycled, must be managed in accordance with §26.121 (Unauthorized Discharges Prohibited) of the Texas Water Code, 30 TAC Chapter §335.4 (General Prohibitions)<sup>3</sup>, and 30 TAC §335.24 (j - l) (related to closure cost estimates, financial assurance, and closure requirements)<sup>4</sup>.

Please note that this letter is neither an approval nor an authorization of the recycling activities being conducted by Trent Wind Farm. It is simply an acknowledgement of the notification of that activity as required by 30 TAC §335.6(h).

<sup>3</sup> It should be noted that §335.4 prohibits: (1) the discharge or imminent threat of discharge of industrial solid waste or municipal hazardous waste into or adjacent to the waters in the state without obtaining specific authorization for such a discharge from the TCEQ, (2) the creation and maintenance of a nuisance; or (3) the endangerment of the public health and welfare.
