#### SITE REVIEW:

In light of the proximity of sensitive receptors and the surrounding land use, please discuss any concerns you have concerning a facility of this type locating at the proposed site.

- The proposed site is located just west of I-45 at El Dorado Boulevard. Most part of this land clearance is located in the Northwest corner of I-45 and El Dorado Boulevard. The land (approximately 30 acres, Key Map Page 617, Section Q, U & V) is located in a developing area.
- The land is an undisturbed soil and not previously excavated or used for any type of landfill operation. At the time of this inspection, we did not see any waste plastic, rubber material, treated lumber or any other waste dump on the site. There are no public schools/recreational parks or businesses/residences located within 300 feet of these two proposed pits.
- Mr. Carlile Pond, company representative, said that the burning project would last for approximately six weeks depending upon the weather conditions. We discussed the special conditions of the trench burning operation and emphasizing precautions for start-up period that may cause excessive emissions and potential complaints for the people working nearby. We also discussed the nuisance potential of ash generated by this operation that may deposit on the vehicles parked in the shopping center and at the car dealer nearby. Mr. Pond assured us that he would comply with all regulatory requirements of the City and State.


