### Project Overview

Windsor Quality Food Company, Ltd. (Windsor) submitted a permit application to operate six meat smokehouses at a site located at 1925 Lone Star Drive, Dallas, Dallas County. The facility currently operates a food processing facility that packages frozen foods. This permit application is for the addition of meat smoking as part of the food preparation process. On December 13, 2012 the company submitted a letter requesting the application be withdrawn. The company proposes to use liquid smoke in their process rather than generating smoke through combustion of sawdust.

## 2. Report Summary

The air quality analysis is not acceptable for all review types and pollutants. The deficiencies are listed below:

- The modeled exit diameters for the dryers (EPNs DR-1, DR-2, DR-3, DR-4, and PO-1) and the proposed common stack (EPN Stack-1) are not consistent with reported values in the full NAAQS modeling for PM<sub>10</sub> and annual NO<sub>2</sub>.
- Elevations for sources, buildings, and receptors were not consistent with the USGS map.
- Downwash was not appropriately included in the full NAAQS analysis for PM<sub>10</sub>.
- The area of impact (AOI) modeling results for 24-hr PM<sub>10</sub> are based on the high second high predicted concentrations.

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- The AOI modeling results for 24-hr PM<sub>2.5</sub> are based on the high second high predicted concentrations.
- The AOI modeling results for 1-hr NO<sub>2</sub> are based on the high sixth high predicted concentrations.
- The AOI modeling results for annual NO<sub>2</sub> are based on the five-year average predicted concentrations.
- The receptor grid used for the AOI modeling for 1-hr NO<sub>2</sub> lacked the spatial coverage needed to identify all areas where the predicted concentration is equal to or greater than the significant impact level (SIL).
- The full NAAQS modeling results for PM<sub>2.5</sub> are incomplete.
- The 1-hr NO<sub>2</sub> full NAAQS modeling results are based on the high sixth high predicted concentrations, and are greater than the NAAQS.
- The monitoring data for years 2008-2010 used for PM<sub>2.5</sub>, PM<sub>10</sub>, and NO<sub>2</sub> are not the most recent data.

The deficiencies should be addressed in the following manner:

- Model the appropriate exit diameters for the dryers (EPNs DR-1, DR-2, DR-3, DR-4, and PO-1) and the proposed common stack (EPN Stack-1) in the full NAAQS modeling for PM<sub>10</sub> and annual NO<sub>2</sub>.
- Elevations for sources, buildings, and receptors should be consistent with the USGS map.
- Downwash should be appropriately account for in the full NAAQS analysis for PM<sub>10</sub>.
- The AOI modeling results for 24-hr PM<sub>10</sub> must be based on the high first high predicted concentrations.
- The AOI modeling results for 24-hr PM<sub>2.5</sub> should be based on the five-year average of the high first high 24-hr predicted concentrations across five years of modeling.
- The AOI modeling results for 1-hr NO<sub>2</sub> should be based on the five-year average of the high first high 1-hr predicted concentrations across five years of modeling.
- The AOI modeling results for annual NO<sub>2</sub> should be based on the highest predicted annual average concentration from five individual years of modeling.
- The modeled receptor grid should have adequate spatial coverage to identify all areas where the predicted concentration is equal to or greater than the SIL for 1-hr NO<sub>2</sub>.
- The PM<sub>2.5</sub> full NAAQS analysis must include an evaluation of other sources in the area.
- The 1-hr NO<sub>2</sub> full NAAQS modeling results should follow the form of the 1-hr NO<sub>2</sub> NAAQS which is the five-year average of the 98<sup>th</sup> percentile of the annual

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distribution of the maximum daily 1-hr concentrations across five years of modeling.

- The monitoring data used as part of the NAAQS analyses for PM<sub>2.5</sub>, PM<sub>10</sub>, and NO<sub>2</sub> should be based on the most recent three years of data.

See sections 3.0 and 4.0 for more details. The applicant should contact the ADMT to discuss the items above prior to conducting additional modeling.

### 3. Model Used and Modeling Techniques

ISC-PRIME (Version 04269) was used. The model used is not compatible with the form of the 24-hr PM<sub>2.5</sub> and 1-hr NO<sub>2</sub> NAAQS. The ADMT recommends using the most recent and readily available version of AERMOD for future modeling. Currently, AERMOD (Version 12060) is the most recent and readily available version of the model.

The background concentration for 24-hr PM<sub>10</sub> was obtained from EPA AIRS monitor 481130050 located at 717 S. Akard Street, Dallas, Dallas County. The applicant reviewed monitoring data for the years 2008 through 2010. The three-year average of the second highest values was selected for the background concentration. The applicant's determination of the 24-hr background concentration is not consistent with ADMT guidance. It is appropriate to select the second highest value from the most recent year of monitoring data.

The background concentrations for PM<sub>2.5</sub> were obtained from EPA AIRS monitor 481130069 located at 1415 Hinton Street, Dallas, Dallas County. The applicant reviewed monitoring data from the years 2008 through 2010. The three-year average of the eighth highest values was selected for the 24-hr background concentration. The three-year average of the annual average values was selected for the annual background concentration. The applicant should follow the same procedures using the most recent three years of monitoring data.

The background concentrations for NO<sub>2</sub> were also obtained from the Hinton Street monitor. The applicant reviewed monitoring data from the years 2008 through 2010. The three-year average of the eighth highest values was selected for the 1-hr background concentration. The applicant's determination of the 1-hr background concentration is not consistent with EPA guidance. It is appropriate to select the 98<sup>th</sup> percentile of the annual distribution of the daily 1-hr maximum concentrations; however, this does not always equate to the high eighth high concentration. Please review Appendix S to Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulation Part 50 for procedures on determining the 98<sup>th</sup> percentile of the annual distribution of the daily 1-hr maximum concentrations. The three-year average of the annual average values was selected for the annual background

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concentration. For the annual background concentration, it is appropriate to select the annual average value from the most recent year of monitoring data.

The applicant did not address nearby sources of PM<sub>2.5</sub> in the full NAAQS modeling demonstration. If the predicted concentrations exceed the associated SIL, the applicant should address total emissions at the site, a representative background concentration, and nearby sources of the same pollutant. The Point Source Data Base (PSDB) does not include PM<sub>2.5</sub> emissions. However, a PSDB retrieval for PM<sub>10</sub> can be used as a conservative surrogate for PM<sub>2.5</sub>. Other recently permitted sources for these pollutants may not be in the PSDB retrieval but should also be evaluated as applicable.

### A. Land Use

Rural dispersion coefficients and elevated terrain were used in the modeling analysis. The selection of rural dispersion is consistent with the Auer land-use analysis. The selection of elevated terrain is consistent with the topographic map; however, the modeled elevations of off-property sources and structures used in the downwash analysis are not consistent with the topographic map.

The ADMT recommends using AERMOD for future modeling purposes. When using AERMOD, a determination of the surface roughness for the project site is necessary in order to select the appropriate meteorological files. This can be accomplished with an analysis of the land use in the area or by using the AERSURFACE program to calculate the surface roughness for the project site.

For future modeling purposes using AERMOD, sources, buildings, and receptors should be selected for elevation determination prior to running AERMAP.

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## C. Receptor Grid

The grid modeled was sufficient in density but not sufficient in spatial coverage to capture representative maximum ground-level concentrations at all significant receptors. The predicted concentrations at the edge of the modeled receptor grid were greater than the SIL for 1-hr NO<sub>2</sub>. The modeled receptor grid should have adequate spatial coverage to identify all areas where the predicted concentration is equal to or greater than the SIL for 1-hr NO<sub>2</sub>.

For the full NAAQS demonstrations, only significant receptors need to be included in the modeled receptor grid.

Some receptors on the north side of the property were modeled on-site. This is conservative.

## D. Building Wake Effects (Downwash)

Input data to Building Profile Input Program Prime (Version 04274) are consistent with the aerial photography.

The heights of a few building tiers represented in the modeling were not consistent with figure 3-2 of the modeling report. The modeled height of 44.5 feet for building tiers eight and eleven were greater than the height of 34.5 feet indicated on figure 3-2. The modeled height of 38.5 feet for building tier fourteen was less than the height of 41.5 feet indicated on figure 3-2. The modeled height of 51 feet for building tier fifteen was greater than the height of 50.5 feet indicated on figure 3-2.

Future modeling should use the appropriate tier heights in the downwash analysis. Additionally, the downwash analysis should be completed after the building elevations have been selected by AERMAP.

## 4. Modeling Emissions Inventory

The modeled emission rates and area source parameters were consistent with the modeling report. The modeled emission point source parameters were not consistent with the modeling report. The source characterizations used to represent the sources were appropriate.

The modeled exit diameter of 0.02 foot for the dryers and 1.55 ft for the proposed common stack is not consistent with reported values in the full NAAQS analysis

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associated with  $PM_{10}$  and annual  $NO_2$ . The reported exit diameter for the dryers is 1.17 ft and 3.25 ft for the proposed common stack.

The modeled emission rates included proposed changes at the plant associated with the proposed common stack. This included emissions from the two boilers (EPNs B1 & B2), two heaters (EPNs H1 & H2), and both cooking lines (EPNs L1\_1, L1\_2, L1\_3, L2\_1, L2\_2, and L2\_3) routed to the proposed common stack. Emission rates from the existing sources (Smokehouses 1-6 and Dryers 1-6) were also included in the model.

To account for the source emissions routed to the proposed common stack, the modeled emission rates from the two boilers, two heaters, and both cooking lines sources were multiplied by 0 during all hours of the day. The full emission rates from the eliminated stacks were included for the proposed common stack.

A  $NO_x$  to  $NO_2$  conversion factor was not applied to the predicted  $NO_x$  concentrations. Use of 0.8 hourly and 0.75 annual factors could be applied to the predicted  $NO_x$  concentrations and would be consistent with guidance for combustion sources.

Maximum allowable hourly emission rates were used for the short-term and long-term averaging time analyses.

## 1.0 PROCESS DESCRIPTION

Quality Sausage Company is located at 1925 Lone Star Drive, Dallas, Dallas County, Texas 75212. It is a food processing plant; its SIC code is 2013. Figure 1 presents an area map. Figure 2 presents a site plan. Appendix A and B present the Core Data and the PI-1 forms respectively for the facility. Appendix C contains Table 30.

Quality Sausage receives raw and frozen meat for its products. Raw meat is ground, seasoned, cooked, smoked for flavor, and incorporated into finished products that are packaged and frozen. The facility operates an ammonia refrigeration system as part of the process. Figure 3 presents a process flow diagram.

Facility emissions result from meat smoking operations and related activities. Emissions calculations may be found in Section 3 of this application. *It should be noted that this permit application pertains only to the smokehouses. All other potential emission sources at the facility have been covered by Permits by Rule and/or Standard Exemptions claimed since the facility began operations.* Table 1, Section 1.2, below lists these potential emission sources claimed under Permits by Rule; none require registration.

### 1.1 Smokehouses

The facility will operate a total of six smokehouses (SH-1 through SH-6). Each smokehouse will exceed the maximum horizontal inside cross-sectional area of 100 square feet as allowed by Permit by Rule 106.243. Three of the smokehouses will contain 12 racks each and three will contain 15 racks each. A maximum of one cooking cycle per smokehouse occurs during daily operations.

The smokehouses use sawdust as the primary source for the smoke generators. Four generators will be used to provide smoke to the six smokehouses. Sawdust is fed onto an electrically-heated metal surface operated at a temperature of between 350 and 400°C. A projected 150 pounds of sawdust will be used on a daily basis. Heat for providing proper operating conditions in the smokehouses is steam generated.

Each smokehouse exhaust will have a diameter of 16 inches. The emission point on each of the six smokehouses is 36.5 ft. above ground level. Smoke from the generators will be drawn through the smokehouses by the recirculating fan. Emissions calculations are in Section 3, below.

### **2.1 BACT**

The operations as described in this application include the following source reductions and emissions control measures and equipment:

- Smokehouse emissions are reduced by controlling the temperature of the smoke generator below 400° C.

### **2.2 State Rules**

**30 TAC 111 – Control of Air Pollution from Visible Emissions and Particulate Matter.** Quality Sausage will maintain compliance with limitations on visible emissions and particulate emissions through the continued application of the controls described in this application.

**30 TAC 112– Control of Air Pollution from Sulfur Compounds.** This rule does not apply to smokehouses.

**30 TAC 113– Standards of Performance for Hazardous Air Pollutants and for Designated Facilities and Pollutants.** The facility is not a major source for Hazardous Air Pollutants. The facility does not have the potential to emit volatile HAPS at major source levels (10 TPY of any single HAP, 25 TPY in aggregate).

**30 TAC 114 – Control of Air Pollution from Motor Vehicles.** No motor vehicle sources are included in the scope of this permit application. All motor vehicles owned or operated by the applicant will comply with the applicable provisions of this regulation including maintenance and operation of air pollution control systems or devices, inspection requirements, equipment evaluation procedures for vehicle exhaust gas analyzers, and use of oxygenated fuels.

**30 TAC 115 – Control of Air Emissions from Volatile Organic Compounds.** The facility is located in Dallas County, which is a non-attainment area for ozone.

### 3.0 EMISSIONS CALCULATIONS – SMOKEHOUSES

Emission calculations were determined for the smokehouses used in the production process. Appendix D presents Table 1(a), emission summary calculations for the facility. Appendix E presents Table 2 - Material Balance.

Smokehouse emission factors are based on data provided in AP-42, Table 9.5.2-1 and -2 for batch and continuous meat smokehouses (PM = 53 lbs/ton of wood; VOC = 44 lbs/ton). Each of the six smokehouses operates 30 minutes per day, but none concurrently or more than one within any one hour period. The result of that cycle, then, may be considered essentially as one 3 hour smoking cycle for each 18 hours of operation per day (6 smokehouses x 0.5 hours = 3 hours). The facility operates six days per week, therefore, the annual operational hours during which emissions are generated from the smokehouses are 936 (3 hours/day x 6 days/week x 52 weeks/year = 936 hours/year).

Based on an operational period of 936 hours per year and a projected use of 150 pounds of sawdust per day (0.075 tons/day) for smoke generation total for all six smokehouses, PM and VOC emissions for the six smokehouses are calculated as shown in the table below. Screen3 results may be found in Appendix F.

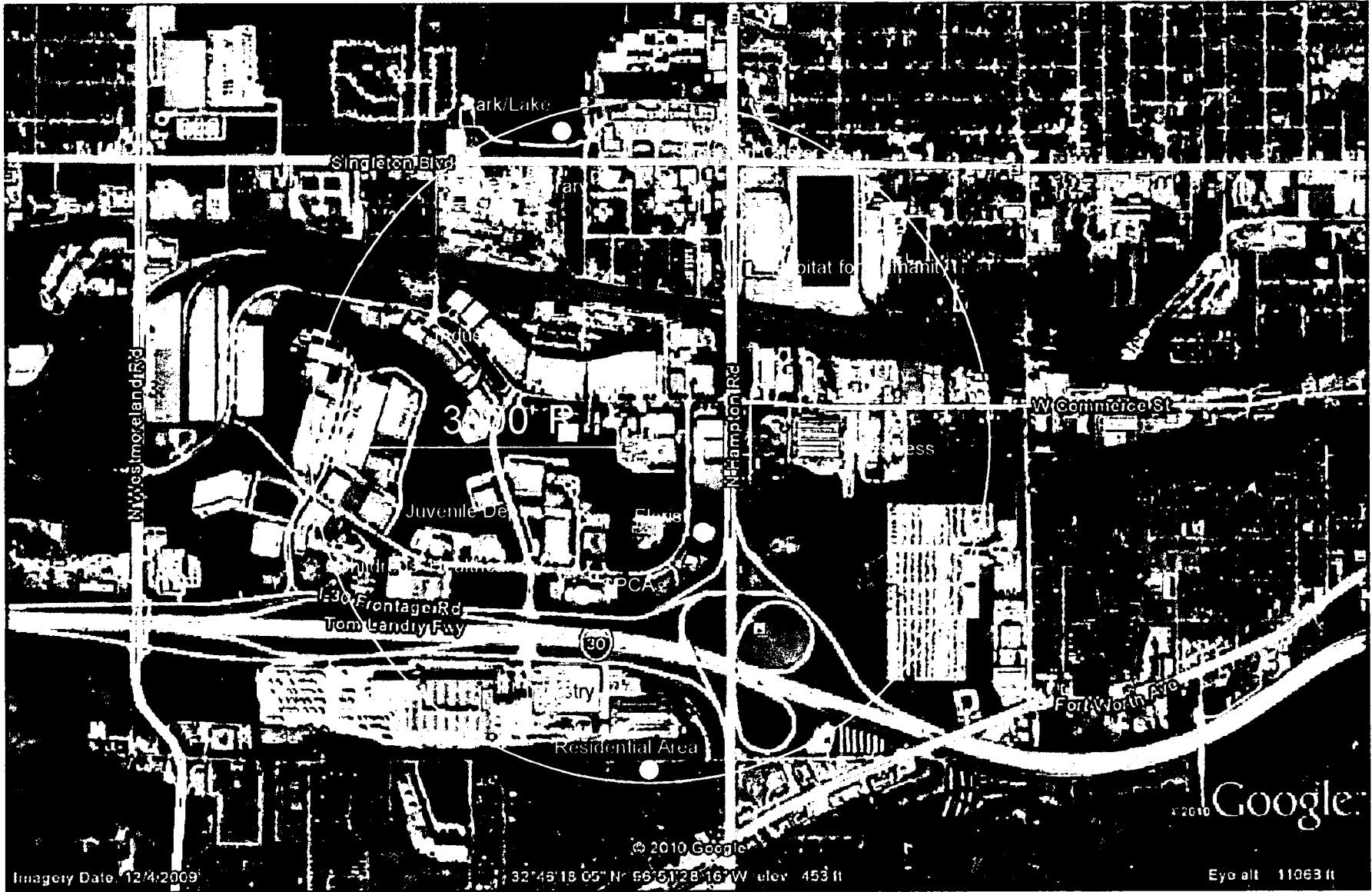

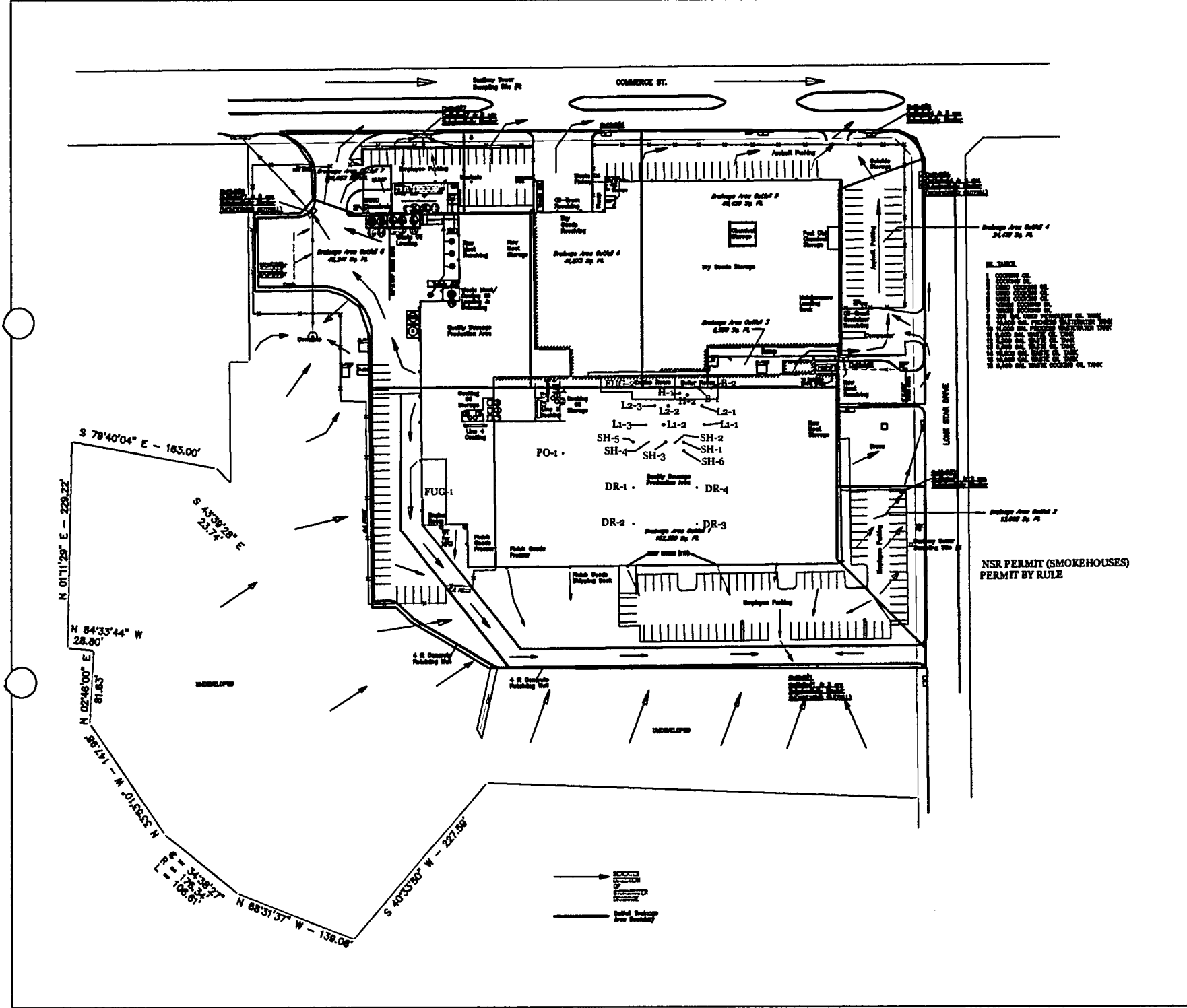
**FIGURE 1**

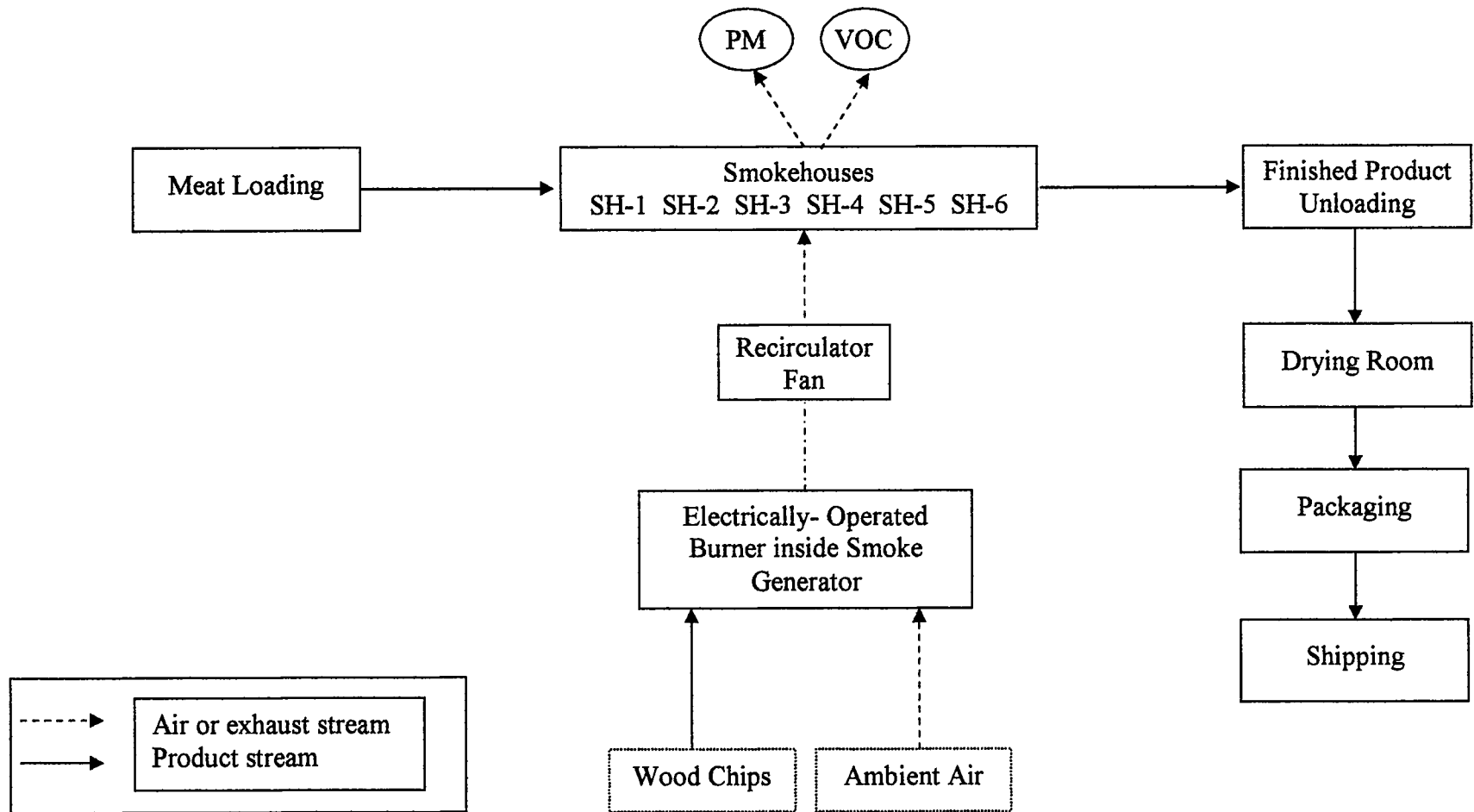

Total annual emissions forecast is: ammonia = 4.01 tons, NOx = 13.3 tons, CO = 16.3, tons, SOx = 0.117 tons, PM2.5 = 2.1 tons, VOC = 1.59 tons and methane = 0.449 tons. A Permit can be claimed based on these estimates for emissions.

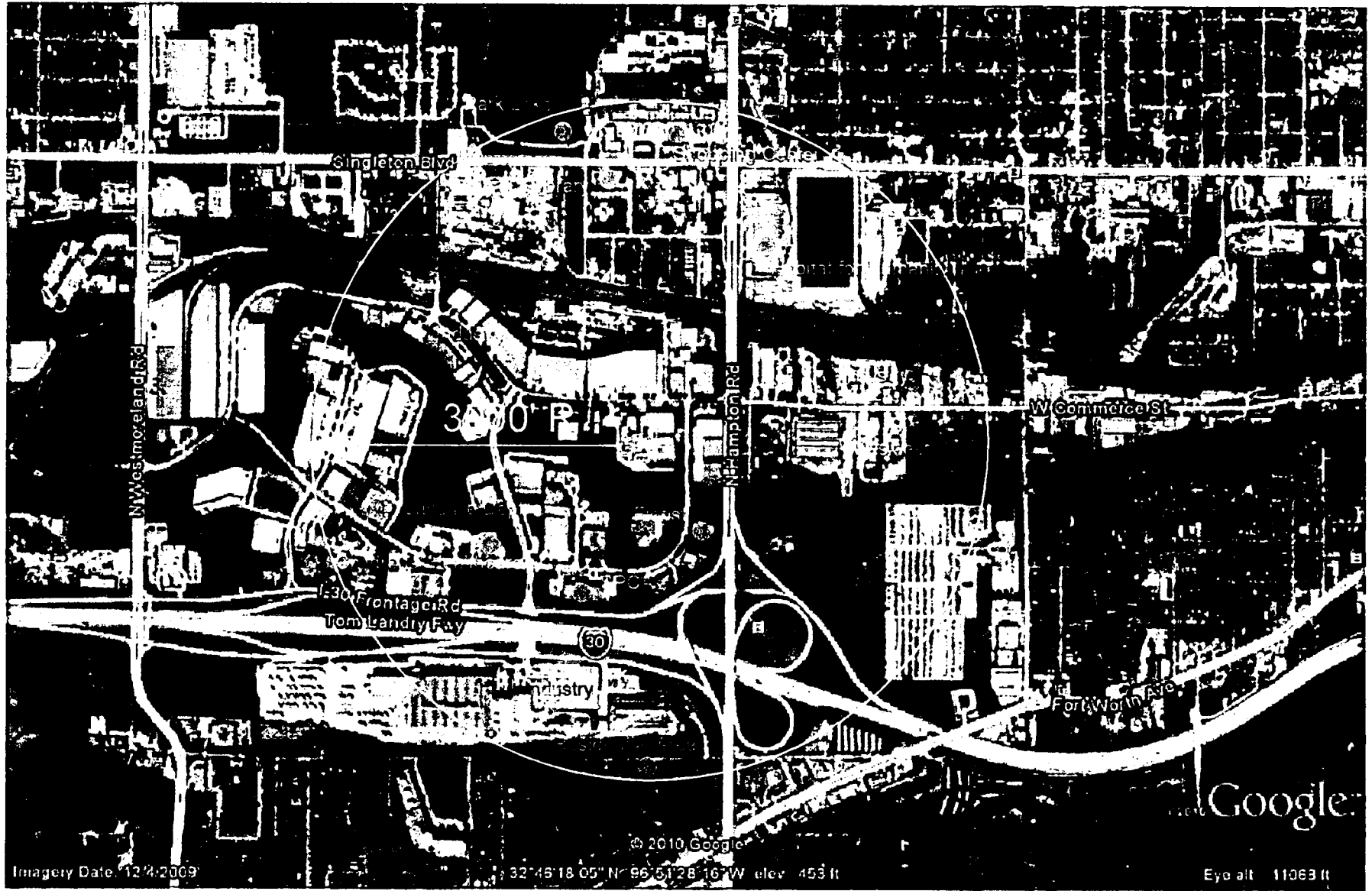

The TCEQ will consider all public comments in developing a final decision on the application. **The deadline to submit public comments is 30 days after newspaper notice is published.**

The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit comments or ask questions about the application. A public meeting about the application will be held if the executive director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.

If only comments are received on the application, the response to comments, along with notice of the executive director's action on the application, will be mailed to everyone who submitted comments or is on the mailing list for this application.

The executive director will complete the technical review, issue a preliminary decision on the application, and a Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision will be published and mailed to those who are on the mailing list for this application. That notice will contain the final deadline for submitting public comments. If a hearing request is timely filed in Response to this Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain Air Permit, the

time period for requesting a contested case hearing will be extended to thirty days after the mailing of the executive director's response to comments.

**After the final deadline for public comments following the Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision, the executive director will consider the comments and prepare a response to all relevant and material, or significant public comments. If comments are received, the response to comments, along with the executive director's decision on the application, will then be mailed to everyone who submitted public comments or is on a mailing list for this application.**

**OPPORTUNITY FOR A CONTESTED CASE HEARING** You may request a contested case hearing. If requesting a contested case hearing, you must submit the following: (1) your name (or for a group or association, an official representative), mailing address, daytime phone number, and fax number, if any; (2) applicant's name and permit number; (3) the statement "[I/we] request a contested case hearing"; (4) a specific description of how you would be adversely affected by the application and air emissions from the facility in a way not common to the general public; (5) the location and distance of your property relative to the facility; and (6) a description of how you use the property which may be impacted by the facility. If the request is made by a group or an association, the one or more members who have standing to request a hearing and the interests which the group or association seeks to protect, must also be identified. You may also submit your proposed adjustments to the application/permit which would satisfy your concerns.**

Following the close of all applicable comment and request periods, the executive director will forward the application and any requests for contested case hearing to the Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting. **If a hearing is granted, the subject of a hearing will be limited to disputed issues of fact relating to relevant and material air quality concerns raised during the comment period.** Issues such as property values, noise, traffic safety, and zoning are outside of the Commission's jurisdiction to address in this proceeding.

## Instructions for Public Notice For New Source Review Air Permit

### Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain Permit

Your application has been declared administratively complete and now you must comply with the following instructions:

#### Review Notice

Included in the notice is all of the information which the commission believes is necessary to effectuate compliance with applicable public notice requirements. Please read it carefully and notify the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. You may not change the text of the notice without prior approval from the TCEQ.

#### Newspaper Notice

- You must publish the enclosed *Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain Permit* within **30 calendar days** after the date of administrative completeness. Refer to the cover letter for the date of administrative completeness.
- You must publish the enclosed *Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain Permit* at your expense, in a newspaper that is of general circulation in the municipality where the facility is or will be located. If the facility is not located within a municipality, the newspaper should be of general circulation in the municipality nearest to the location or proposed location.
- You must publish this notice in one issue of any applicable newspaper.
- You will find two example notices enclosed in this package. *Example A* must be published in the "public notice" section of the newspaper. The phrase "Example A" is not required to be published. *Example B* must be published in the **same issue** of the newspaper as *Example A*; however, it must be published in a prominent location (other than the public notice section). *Example B* refers the public to the "public notice" section of the newspaper where *Example A* provides more information regarding the permit application.
- *Example B* must be a total of at least **6 column inches (standard advertising units)** with a height of at least **3 inches** and a horizontal dimension of **2 column widths**. If the

newspaper chosen does not use standard advertising units for measurement, the notice must be at least **12 square inches** with the shortest side at least 3 inches.

- The bold text of the enclosed notice **must** be printed in the newspaper in a font style or size that distinguishes it from the rest of the notice (i.e., **bold**, *italics*). **Failure to do so may require re-notice.**

### **Alternative Language Notice**

In certain circumstances, applicants for air permits must complete notice in alternative languages.

- Public notice rules require the applicant to determine whether a bilingual program is required at either the elementary or middle school nearest to the facility or proposed facility location. Bilingual education programs are determined on a district-wide basis. When students who are required to attend either school are eligible to be enrolled in a bilingual education program, some alternative language notice is required (signs, or signs and newspaper notice).
- Since the school district, and not the schools, must provide the bilingual education program, these programs do not have to be located at the elementary or middle school nearest to the facility or proposed facility to trigger the alternative language notice requirement. If there are students who would normally attend the nearest schools eligible to be taught in a bilingual education program at a different location, alternative language notice is required.
- If triggered, publication of alternative language notices must be made in a newspaper or publication primarily printed in each language taught in the bilingual education program. This notice is required if such a newspaper or publication exists in the municipality or the county where the facility is or will be located.
- The applicant must demonstrate a good faith effort to identify a newspaper or publication in the required language. If a newspaper or publication of general circulation published at least once a month in such language cannot be found, publishing in that language is not required, but signs must still be posted adjacent to each English language sign.
- Publication in an alternative language section or insertion within an English language newspaper does not satisfy these requirements.
- The applicant has the burden to demonstrate compliance with these requirements. You must fill out the ***Public Notice Verification Form (Form TCEQ-20244)*** indicating your compliance with the requirements regarding publication in an alternative language. **This form is available at [www.tceq.texas.gov/permitting/air/nav/air\\_publicnotice.html](http://www.tceq.texas.gov/permitting/air/nav/air_publicnotice.html).**
- It is suggested the applicant work with the local school district to do the following:
  - (1) determine if a bilingual program is required in the district;
  - (2) determine which language is required by the bilingual program;

- (3) locate the nearest elementary and middle schools; and
- (4) determine if any students attending either school are eligible to be enrolled in a bilingual educational program.

- **If you determine that you must meet the alternative language notice requirements, you are responsible for ensuring that the publication in the alternative language is complete and accurate in that language. Spanish notice templates are available through the Air Permits Division Web site at [www.tceq.texas.gov/permitting/air/nav/air\\_publicnotice.html](http://www.tceq.texas.gov/permitting/air/nav/air_publicnotice.html).** All italic notes should be replaced with the corresponding Spanish translations for the specific application and published in the alternative language publication.
- If you are required to publish notice in a language other than Spanish, you must translate the entire public notice at your own expense.

### **Public Comment Period**

- The public comment period should last at least **30 calendar days**.
- The comment period will be longer if the last day of the public comment period ends on a weekend or a holiday. In this case, the comment period will end on the next business day.
- The comment period for the permit may lengthen depending on whether a public meeting is held. If a public meeting is held, the comment period will be extended to the later of either the date of the public meeting or the end of the second notice period.

### **Proof of Publication**

- Check each publication to ensure that the articles were accurately published. If a notice was not published correctly you may be required to republish.
- For each newspaper in which you published, you must submit **original newspaper clippings or tear sheets** of each published notice which shows the complete notice that was published, the date of publication, and the name of the newspaper to the Office of the Chief Clerk within **10 business days** after the date of publication.
- You must submit an **original affidavit of publication for air permitting and alternate language affidavit of publication for air permitting (if applicable)** to the Office of the Chief Clerk within **30 calendar days** after the date of publication. **You must use the enclosed affidavit forms.** The affidavits must clearly identify the applicant's name and permit number. You are encouraged to submit the affidavit with the original newspaper clippings described above.
- You must submit the ***Public Notice Verification Form (Form TCEQ-20244)*** to the Office of the Chief Clerk within **10 business days** of the end of this public comment
