Dear Mr. Coffman:

This is in response to your letter dated April 23, 1997 concerning the existing paperboard printers. After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that these printers are exempt from the permit procedures under 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Section 106.418 (formerly identified as Standard Exemption 13) if operated as described in your letter. These sources of emissions will be removed from Permit No. 6545A.

This standard exemption was authorized by the Executive Director of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) pursuant to 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 106. A copy of the exemption in effect at the time of this determination is enclosed. You must operate in accordance with all requirements of the enclosed standard exemption.

You are reminded that regardless of whether a permit is required, these facilities must be in compliance with all rules and regulations of the TNRCC and of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency at all times.
