Dear Mr. Patton:

This is in response to your letter received January 26, 2001 concerning the cabinet door manufacturing facility near Austin in Travis County. We understand that the proposed facility will not exceed total emissions of 25 tons per year in any consecutive 12 months.

After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your project is authorized under 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Section 106.231 if constructed and operated as described in your letter. This permit by rule was authorized by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) pursuant to 30 TAC Chapter 106.

A copy of the permit by rule in effect at the time of this registration is enclosed. You must construct, install, or modify facilities in accordance with the version of the permit by rule in effect when construction, installation, or modification actually begins (see 30 TAC §106.4[a][5]). After completion of construction, installation, or modification, the facility shall be operated in compliance with the all applicable conditions of the claimed permit by rule and 30 TAC §106.4.

You are reminded that regardless of whether a permit is required, these facilities must be in compliance with all rules and regulations of the TNRCC and of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency at all times.



The manufacturer guarantees there will be no visible emissions following the filter. Also, waste materials will be dropped into an 8 yard dumpster through a canvas (or similar material) chute, and will be carried away by a local waste management company such as BFI.

The basis for my request for exempt status is TNRCC rule 106.231, paragraphs (1) and (2).
