Dear Mr. Chapman:

This is in response to your permit by rule, Form PI-7-261, concerning the modified operation of the Westside Cotton Gin located at 5117 Cottonseed road near the City of San Angelo, in Tom Green County, Texas. We understand that these modifications include the replacement addition of the Burr Fan (Emission Point No. F-7) with a similar, slightly larger fan which produces the same air-flow at lower rotations per minute and the addition of a new humidification system to the gin which consists of a humidifier and a fan that will blow moist air through the lint slide. The humidification system is being installed in order to improve cotton quality and neither modification will have an effect on the capacity of the gin. It is recognized that the overall operations of this cotton gin are authorized under the Office of Air Quality Permit Number 25655.

The routine emissions associated with the humidification system's burner have been estimated at 0.12 tons per year (tpy) of volatile organic compounds, 0.002 tpy of sulfur dioxide, 0.41 tpy of nitrogen oxides, 0.07 tpy of carbon monoxide, and 0.01 tpy of particulate matter equal to or less than 10 microns in diameter.

After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that the similar functioning burr fan replacement is authorized under Title 30 Texas Administrative Code § 106.264 (30 TAC § 106.261), while the humidification system is authorized under 30 TAC § 106.261, if all is constructed and operated as described in your registration request. These permits by rule were authorized by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) pursuant to 30 TAC Chapter 106.
