Dear Mr. Billinger:

This is in response to your permit by rule registration, Form PI-7, concerning the replacement of four boilers for a new steam generator at your Featherlite Building Products facility. We understand that the emissions represented in your claim are a theoretical worst case scenario, when the generator operates continuously 365 days per year. The total emissions associated with the referenced activities are estimated to be 0.12 ton per year (tpy) of volatile organic compounds, 2.19 tpy of nitrogen oxides, 1.83 tpy of carbon monoxide, 0.013 tpy of sulfur dioxide, and 0.16 tpy of particulate matter less than or equal to ten microns in diameter.

After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your replacement is authorized under 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Section 106.183 if constructed and operated as described in your registration request. This permit by rule was authorized by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) pursuant to 30 TAC Chapter 106.

A copy of the permit by rule in effect at the time of this registration is enclosed. You must construct, install, or modify facilities in accordance with the version of the permit by rule in effect when construction, installation, or modification actually begins [see 30 TAC §106.4(a)(5)]. After completion of construction, installation, or modification, the facility shall be operated in compliance with the all applicable conditions of the claimed permit by rule and 30 TAC §106.4.
