This is in response to your letter dated May 4, 2001 concerning the replacement of the existing asphalt plant and its components at the San Leon Asphalt Plant located at 5300 27th Street near San Leon, Galveston County. We understand that replacement asphalt plant will function in the same manner as the existing plant with no increase in capacity, production rate or throughput. The overall air emissions from the new asphalt plant will be less than the present overall emissions and emissions of each air contaminant from the replacement facility be less than 25 tons per year.

You are reminded that Permit 18728A remains in effect and that the replacement equipment must be operated completely within its requirements. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Section 116.116(d), this permit by rule claim will be rolled into Permit 18728A when it is amended or renewed

After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your proposed registration is authorized under 30 TAC §106.264 if operated as described in your registration request. This permit by rule was authorized by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) pursuant to 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 106.

A copy of the permit by rule in effect at the time of this registration is enclosed. You must operate in accordance with the version of the permit by rule in effect when operation actually begins (see 30 TAC Chapter 106.4[a][5]). After completion of construction the facility shall be operated in compliance with all applicable conditions of the claimed permits by rule and 30 TAC Chapter 106.4.
