Yes, while the standard permit issuance letter does not specifically mention the urea management units associated with the Generator-Engine Sets authorized under Standard Permit 51806 issued on 10/16/02, they are also covered by this permit. The urea storage tanks, associated fugitives, and ammonia emissions from the gen-sets were included in the permit representations at the time of the original permit application and were reviewed as part of the initial permitting process. I will put a copy of this email in the permanent file as well to maintain a record that the urea management units are indeed authorized. If you have any further questions, feel free to contact me.

As we discussed on 12/02/03, it is my understanding that the urea management units associated with the Generator-Engine Sets authorized under Standard Permit 51806 issued on 10/16/02 are also covered by this permit since the units are auxiliary items associated with the generator-engine sets. Also the projected urea emissions from these units were provided to the TCEQ during the Standard Permit review. The urea management units associated with the Generator-Engine Sets are as follows:

UR-1	South Urea Storage Tank
UR-2	North Urea Storage Tank
SUR-1	South Urea Day Tank 1
SUR-2	South Urea Day Tank 2
SUR-3	South Urea Day Tank 3
SUR-4	South Urea Day Tank 4
NUR-1	North Urea Day Tank 1
NUR-2	North Urea Day Tank 2
NUR-3	North Urea Day Tank 3

I would appreciate your providing acknowledgement that these units and associated piping are covered by Standard Permit 51806.
