Dear Mr. Radovanov:

This is in response to your letter dated August 1, 1997 concerning the proposed Tire Recycling Facility. After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your project is exempt from the permit procedures under 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Section 106.261 if constructed and operated as described in your letter. We understand that the tire recycling process is enclosed and the grinders, cracken mills, shakers, classifiers, and bagging operation exhaust to a cyclone.

This exemption was authorized by the Executive Director of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) pursuant to 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 106.261. A copy of the exemption in effect at the time of this determination is enclosed. You must operate in accordance with all requirements of the enclosed exemption.

You are reminded that regardless of whether a permit is required, these facilities must be in compliance with all rules and regulations of the TNRCC and of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency at all times.
