Dear Mr. McGill:

This is in response to your letter dated March 4, 1997 concerning the new construction and operation of a 40,000 barrel above ground internal floating roof storage tank at the Woodville Station located near Woodville, in Tyler County. After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your project is exempt from the permit procedures under 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Section 106.478 if constructed and operated as described in your letter. We understand the routine emissions associated with the operation of this new storage tank are estimated at 2.90 tons per year of volatile organic compounds.

This standard exemption was authorized by the Executive Director of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) pursuant to 30 TAC Chapter 106. A copy of the exemption in effect at the time of this determination is enclosed. You must operate in accordance with all requirements of the enclosed standard exemption.

You are reminded that regardless of whether a permit is required, this facility must be in compliance with all rules and regulations of the TNRCC and of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) at all times. In addition, this

facility shall comply with all requirements of the EPA Regulations on Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources promulgated for Volatile Organic Storage Vessels in Title 40 Code of federal regulations Part 60, Subparts A and Kb.
