Dear Mr. Littleton:

This is in response to your letter dated November 11, 1996, concerning the proposed operation of a wrecking ball and screening equipment to demolish and remove a concrete structure at the Alamo Concrete site in Port Aransas. After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your project is exempt from the permit procedures under Standard Exemption 106 if constructed and operated as described in your letter. We understand that the screen will be controlled by the use of water sprays, and the maximum thruput of the operation will not exceed 100 tons per hour.

This standard exemption was authorized by the Executive Director of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) pursuant to 30 TAC Section 116.211(a) of Regulation VI. A copy of the exemption in effect at the time of this determination is enclosed. You must operate in accordance with all requirements of the enclosed standard exemption.

You are reminded that regardless of whether a permit is required, these facilities must be in compliance with all rules and regulations of the TNRCC and of the U.S. Environmental
