This is in response to your letter dated June 28, 1996 concerning the proposed tetraethyl ammonium bromide production and a new 6,000 gallon storage tank. After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your project is exempt from the permit procedures under Standard Exemption 51 and 106 if constructed and operated as described in your letter.

The standard exemptions were authorized by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission Executive Director pursuant to 30 TAC Section 116.211(a) of Regulation VI. Copies of the exemptions in effect at the time of this determination are enclosed. You must operate in accordance with all requirements of the enclosed standard exemptions.

You are reminded that regardless of whether a permit is required, these facilities must be in compliance with all air quality rules and regulations of the TNRCC and of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency at all times.
