Dear Mr. Hay:

This is in response to your letter dated May 13, 1996 concerning the proposed operation of a stencil cleaner at the facility at 5555 North Beach Street in Tarrant County. After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your project is exempt from the permit procedures under Standard Exemption 106 if constructed and operated as described in your letter. We understand that you are also notifying us that you will not operate the two wave solder machines that you have previously proposed to use at this site.

This standard exemption was authorized by the Executive Director of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) pursuant to 30 TAC Section 116.211(a) of Regulation VI. A copy of the exemption in effect at the time of this determination is enclosed. You must operate in accordance with all requirements of the enclosed standard exemption.

You are reminded that regardless of whether a permit is required, these facilities must be in compliance with all air quality rules and regulations of the TNRCC and of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency at all times.
