Dear Mr. Burrage:

This is in response to your letter dated March 19, 1996 concerning the replacement of your burn-out oven previously considered exempt from permitting under Standard Exemption. After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your replacement burn-out oven is exempt from the permit procedures under Standard Exemption 111 if installed and operated as described in your letter.

This standard exemption was authorized by the Executive Director of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) pursuant to 30 TAC Section 116.211(a) (Regulation VI). A copy of the exemption in effect at the time of this determination is enclosed. You must operate in accordance with all requirements of the enclosed standard exemption.

You are reminded that regardless of whether a permit is required, these facilities must be in compliance with all air quality rules and regulations of the TNRCC and of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency at all times.
