This is in response to your registration form PI-7 concerning your existing automotive Surface Coating Booth (B-1). After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your work is exempt from the permit procedures under Standard Exemption No. 89, effective September 23, 1982, if operated as described in your letter.

This standard exemption was authorized by the Executive Director pursuant to Texas Air Control Board (now known as the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission [TNRCC]) Regulation VI. A copy of the exemption in effect at that time is attached. You must operate in accordance with all requirements of the attached standard exemption.

You are reminded that regardless of whether a permit is required, these facilities must be in compliance with all air quality Rules and Regulations of the TNRCC and of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) at all times.
