Waco, McLennan County

Dear Mr. Simmons:

This is in response to your letter concerning the proposed installation of two new 20.1 million BTU/hour boilers at 8400 Imperial Drive in Waco, McLennan County. We understand that the boilers will have Webster low NO_x burners and will have an anticipated NO_x emission rate of 0.037 pounds per million BTU/hour.

After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your proposed installation is exempt from permitting procedures under Standard Exemption No. 7 if constructed and operated as described in your letter. This standard exemption was authorized by the Executive Director pursuant to Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) Rule 116.211 of Regulation VI. A copy of the exemption in effect at the time of this registration is enclosed. You must operate in accordance with all requirements of the enclosed standard exemption.

You are reminded that regardless of whether a permit is required, these facilities must be in compliance with all air quality Rules and Regulations of the TNRCC and of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) at all times. In addition, these facilities shall comply with all requirements of EPA Regulations on Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources promulgated for Small Industrial Commercial Institutional Steam Generating Units in Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations Part 60, Subparts A and Dc.
