This is in response to your letter dated July 21, 1993, concerning the proposed steel slag processing facility. After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your project is exempt from the permit procedures under Standard Exemption No. 106, if constructed and operated as described in your letter and the operation does not exceed 35 ton/hour. This standard exemption was previously authorized by the Executive Director pursuant to Texas Air Control Board (TACB) Regulation VI, Rule 116.6. A copy of the exemption in effect at the time of this registration is attached. You must operate in accordance with all requirements of the attached standard exemption.

You are reminded that regardless of whether a permit is required, these facilities must be in compliance with all Rules and Regulations of the TACB and of the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) at all times. If the exempt construction or installation affects a permitted facility, an amendment may be required pursuant to Regulation VI, Rule 116.5.
