Dear Mr. Frederickson:

This is in response to your letter dated August 23, 1994, concerning the proposed replacement of three airdyne cyclones and one bag filter system with two high efficiency baghouse systems. We understand that these systems control emissions from grandfatherd portions of your facility.

After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your proposed replacement, installation, relocation, revision will not create a new source of air contaminants or increase emissions of air contaminants from existing sources. On this basis, no permit will be required. You are reminded that regardless of whether a construction permit is required, this facility must be in compliance with all air quality Rules and Regulations of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission at all times.
