INTRODUCTION:

On January 11, 2022, Ms. Lisa E. Merritt of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Houston Region Office conducted an investigation of the above-referenced facility to evaluate compliance with applicable requirements for Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 334 Underground and Aboveground Storage Tanks regulations for the Petroleum Storage Tank (PST) Program at motor vehicle fuel dispensing facilities.

Kroger Texas L. P. owns and manages the property and underground storage tanks (USTs). Mr. Rudy Salas and Ms. Melissa Rutledge are the facility contacts.

The investigator notified Mr. Salas and Ms. Rutledge on January 7, 2022, by email, requesting compliance documentation to be sent electronically and that a noncontact on-site investigation would be conducted on January 11, 2022. Mr. Salas and Ms. Rutledge were provided with a list of the requested compliance documentation on January 7, 2022, via email

GENERAL FACILITY AND PROCESS INFORMATION:

This site is a grocery store fuel facility with retail sales of gasoline fuel with a monthly throughput of approximately 390,000 gallons.

According to the TCEQ PARIS database, there are two fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) USTs installed at the facility. The tanks were installed May 29, 2016. Tank 1 has a capacity of 20,000 gallons and stores gasoline fuel. Tank 2 has a capacity of 18,000 gallons and has two compartments. Compartment 2A has a capacity of 8,000 gallons and stores gasoline fuel. Compartment 2B has a capacity of 10,000 gallons and stores diesel fuel.

BACKGROUND:

On January 22, 2019, a Petroleum Storage Tank Focused Energy Act Investigation was conducted, CCEDS Investigation 1540368, where the facility was found compliant.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

PST documentation available included a current, valid TCEQ PST delivery certificate with an expiration date of February 28, 2022. Financial assurance is provided through an insurance policy that expires on May 1, 2022. Corrosion protection is provided through FRP USTs and verified by Alert technologies (Attachment 1). The facility utilizes Interstitial Monitoring (IM) as its primary Release Detection method for the tanks and lines. The 30-day IM reports were reviewed from January 7, 2021 through January 7, 2022. The lines were also tested with the leak detectors on February 9, 2021 by B & F Maintenance Service, Inc. The leak detection records did not indicate a suspected release. Ball float valves are installed on the tanks and verified by B & F Maintenance Service, Inc. (Attachment 1). Mr. Josh White is the facility's certified Class A and B Operator and the Class C Operator training log was being maintained on-site.

An exit interview was conducted via email on January 13, 2022, where Mr. Salas and Ms. Rutledge were notified of the investigation findings.

CONCLUSION:

No violations were noted during the investigation.

A General Compliance (GC) letter has been issued as a result of the investigation.

On January 11, 2022, Ms. Lisa E. Merritt of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Houston Region Office conducted an investigation of the above-referenced facility to evaluate compliance with applicable requirements for petroleum storage tanks (PSTs) for motor vehicle fuel dispensing facilities. No violations were documented during the investigation.






