Hi Joseph,

To clarify my previous email, the reason I asked about the form OP-2 is because the unit attributes that are being submitted for ENG-6 as part of this GOP revision application are different from the unit attributes that the other units in GRP-ENGs had in the initial application for this GOP. So, since you are submitting new unit attribute information for the whole group, that must be documented on the form OP-2.

Also, units that are in a group should not be listed individually on OP-UA forms. The correct way to list units within groups on OP-UA forms is to list them on a single line using the group's Group ID No. under the Unit ID No. column.

So, for documentation purposes, provide form OP-2 and form OP-UA2 with edits that reflect the above information. The OP-2 form should have a revision description that states that the unit attributes for the entire group will be updated; and the OP-UA2 form should have the group listed on a single line by its Group ID No. Please do so by 01/27/2023.

To clarify my previous email, the reason I asked about the form OP-2 is because the unit attributes that are being submitted for ENG-6 as part of this GOP revision application are different from the unit attributes that the other units in GRP-ENGs had in the initial application for this GOP. So, since you are submitting new unit attribute information for the whole group, that must be documented on the form OP-2.

Also, units that are in a group should not be listed individually on OP-UA forms. The correct way to list units within groups on OP-UA forms is to list them on a single line using the group's Group ID No. under the Unit ID No. column.

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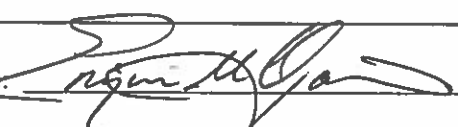

The Coyote Compressor Station (the CS) is located northwest of Cayanosa, Texas in Pecos County. This CS is the application area for revision of Permit/ Authorization to Operator Number O4190 under Title V General Operating Permit (GOP) Number 514. The CS is owned and operated by XTO Energy Inc.

This application addresses GOP No. 514 as last revised on January 12, 2021. This revision is submitted to revise the engine equipment group by removing one engine and adding one engine. The removed engine will stay on location, inoperable.

Field gas flows into the inlet slug catchers for initial two-phase separation. Separated liquids will flow to the 3-phase low-pressure separator. The gas will be routed to the natural gas engines to compress the gas for sales or gas lift to nearby wells. The facility consists of three (3) Caterpillar 3616TA engines and three (3) Caterpillar 3516J engines. The engines are equipped with oxidation catalysts to reduce CO, VOC, and formaldehyde emissions. Gas is treated for H₂S at nearby batteries, but a conservative H₂S value is used for permitting purposes.

Gas is dehydrated using triethylene glycol dehydration units with a capacity of 70 MMscfd each. The dehydrators are equipped with a flash tank and a condenser. Flash tank vapors are recycled back to the facility inlet but can be routed to flare for M55 events. The glycol still vent vapors are routed to the condenser. Uncondensed vapors are routed to the flare for destruction. The vapors can also be routed to the reboiler as an alternate operating scenario. Dehydrated gas is then transferred to a sales pipeline or used for gas lift for nearby wells.

Low pressure liquids from the knockouts, sumps, drains, and 1st and 2nd stages of compression are routed to the low pressure separator. The gas is captured by two electric VRUs which route the gas back to the inlet. Separated water is routed to the skim tanks and oil is routed to the oil tanks. The skim tanks are arranged as a redundant system in which one unit can be used if another is down for unforeseen circumstances. Oil is dumped to four (4) oil storage tanks and water is dumped to two (2) water tanks. Liquids can be pumped offsite or truck loaded. Truck loading is represented as an alternate operating scenario (AOS) and is now controlled by the LP flare. Vapors from the skim tanks and storage tanks are controlled by the flare system.

Compressor rodpacking vents are routed to the flare and is considered steady state emissions. High pressure dumps from the 3rd and 4th stages of compression can be routed routed to a 3-phase high pressure separator during periods of high liquid dropout. If this scenario occurs, the separated gas and water are routed back to the inlet. The separated NGLs are pumped offsite to sales or routed to a pressurized bullet tank and trucked offsite periodically to sales. There are no emissions associated with NGL loading as any displaced vapors are routed back to the inlet. The high pressure dumps can also be routed back to the inlet slug catcher for recycle.

The flare system consists of one flare. The flare will also be used during emergency events. During VRU downtime, low pressure separator vapors are routed to flare.

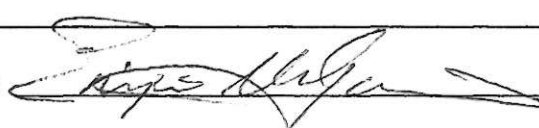
