Good Morning,

A detailed process description is provided in Section 4 of the Application; as well as a Process Flow Diagram in Section 3 of the application.

This facility is a chemical storage and distribution operation.

- Chemicals arrive at the facility by bulk truck or container (Iso-Tanks, Totes, Drums, Pails, etc.).
- Bulk trucks are offloaded into one of the 6 above ground storage tanks.
- Chemicals from the above storage tanks are loaded into containers.
- Chemicals are also transferred from container to container (i.e., Iso-Tank to Tote, Tote to tote, tote to drum, drum to pail, tote to pail, Iso-Tank to pail, Iso-Tank to drum, etc.).
- Chemicals are delivered to customers in the container of the customers choosing.
- Partial containers may also be combined into a single container.

No bulk trucks are loaded at this facility.

All operations have been authorized under non-registered 106.472 and 106.473. With this specific registration application, the following PBR authorizations are represented:

- 1) §106.262 - Facilities (Emission and Distance Limitations); and (2) §106.473 - Organic Liquid Loading and Unloading.

This PBR Registration application is being submitted to request approval for the chemical handling operations to store and transfer chemical mixtures that contain ethyl benzene, naphthalene, sulfuric acid, and/or toluene mixed with other compounds which are authorized under §106.473. These four chemicals will only be in containers (not the bulk tanks), and only be transferred from containers to containers on site, as needed for delivery to customers.

TCEQ will retain the original permit fee for six months and you will not need to submit additional fees with the new application if the original fee was paid correctly.
