Trinity Consultants, Inc. is providing these documents to register a Permit by Rule (PBR) under 30 TAC §106.264 to authorize a temporary replacement of facilities at the Chambers County Concrete Crushing Plant. We have provided a Regional Notification Form, Core Data Form, and a 264 Checklist as required for this notification attached to this letter.

Texas Materials Group is making some site improvements at the Chambers County site to include additional paving and other needed improvements to assist with dust control and to allow easier access to the permanent facilities. During this time, the primary crusher will not be able to operate. Therefore, we are notifying you that we will operate an additional crusher at this site for a period of 6 to 12 weeks while these improvements are being implemented. Following the conclusion of these site improvements, we will restore the operation of the primary crusher and some of the associated equipment (conveyors and screens) to their normal operations as permitted under NSR permit 51817. The temporary operations will not exceed any prior representations on the NSR Permit.
