To Whom It May Concern:

Eco Services Operations Corp. (Eco Services) owns and operates a sulfuric acid manufacturing plant in Baytown (Baytown Plant). The Baytown Plant currently operates under the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Account Number HG-0696-Q. Eco Services has a TCEQ Customer Reference Number CN605004464 and the Baytown Plant is registered with a Regulated Entity Number RN100211317.

Eco Services is hereby submitting a notification of off-permit changes to their Title V permit, issued by the TCEQ on August 3, 2016. Eco Services is requesting the incorporation of the following emission units authorized under Title 30 of the Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC) 106 which do not require registration with the TCEQ:

- Temporary Compressors/Pumps/Engines and Dry Abrasive Blasting Activities under Permit by Rule (PBR) §106.263 Routine Maintenance, Start-up and Shutdown of Facilities, and Temporary Maintenance Facilities
- ➤ Wet Blasting Activities under PBR §106.451 Wet Blast Cleaning
- ➤ A Remote Reservoir Cleaner under PBR §106.454—Degreasing Units
- ➤ Portable and Emergency Engines under PBR §106.511 Portable and Emergency Engines and Turbines

Aside from the PBR authorizations being claimed, the proposed project does not trigger new site-wide or unit specific applicable requirements, and there is no change to the existing applicable requirements. Eco Services is submitting this letter to notify TCEQ and the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) of off-permit changes at the Baytown Plant. DESCRIPTION OF OFF-PERMIT CHANGES

The activities associated with this project meet the applicable requirements set forth in 30 TAC §122.222(k) for off-permit changes as described below. Rule language is included in italics.

- (k) An off-permit change may be made at a site, when the following conditions are met:
- (1) The change shall meet all applicable requirements and shall not violate any existing permit term or condition;

The project will meet applicable requirements and does not violate existing permit terms or conditions.

(2) The permittee shall provide written notice to the executive director and the EPA administrator concurrent with each such change, except for changes that qualify as insignificant activities. Such written notice shall describe each such change, including the date, any change in emissions, pollutants emitted, and any applicable requirement that would apply as a result of the change;

Eco Services is submitting this written notification to both TCEQ and the U.S. EPA.

(3) The change shall not qualify for the permit shield under §122.148; and

This notification does not add to or modify the permit shield.

(4) The permittee shall keep a record of any off-permit changes with the permit.
