Modern Geosciences, LLC (Modern) is pleased to provide the attached Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP) Application Package to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for the above-referenced property (Site) prepared on behalf of the City of Dallas (VCP Applicant).

Between January 2018 and May 2019, Blue Star Recycling collected asphalt roof shingles on its leased property in order to process the shingle material into a substance that could be used in paving and asphalt road-mix products. In response to community concerns and non-compliance at the Site, the City and Texas Commission on Environmental Quality engaged in legal action in an effort to see the property owner and operator address concerns.

On December 10, 2020, the Court signed an Agreed Final Judgment. In exchange, the City of Dallas agreed to remove and dispose of the solid waste at the property and to perform an environmental site assessment. The City engaged a contractor to assist in the removal of all remaining shingle material at the property. The material was moved to the City of Dallas' McCommas Bluff Landfill and is being properly recycled. This process included mitigation efforts to minimize the impact on the neighboring community and employed air quality monitoring both on and off the property throughout the removal event. As part of the assessment process, elevated lead concentrations were noted in surface soils at the Site apparently related to prior fill material placed at the Site prior to the shingle recycling operations.



As the current owner of the Site, the City of Dallas has completed the delineation of lead to residential goals and will address remaining corrective action through the Texas VCP.



perform the voluntary cleanup. The Executive Director may also request additional information to support this affirmation.

With this Intent to Participate, the undersigned does not admit or assume liability for investigation or cleanup of the site. In addition, the undersigned may terminate the Intent to Participate at any time. If the TCEQ rejects the application, it will notify the applicant and explain the reasons for rejection and will refund half of the application deposit, unless the applicant indicates a desire to resubmit a corrected application. An applicant can resubmit an application once without submitting an additional application fee, if the applicant resubmits within 45 days after the rejection notice date.

Regulatory Activity Summary

Former Blue Star Recycling 9505 and 9527 South Central Expressway Dallas, Dallas County, Texas

The Site previously operated as an asphaltic roof-shingle recycling facility that operated at 9505 and 9527 South Central Expressway between January 2018 and April 2019. In April 2019, a court order was issued to Blue Star Recycling (BSR) to stop accepting and processing building materials (shingles, wood, brick, etc.) and remove the waste material from the Site.

According to the TCEQ Central Registry, a complaint was received by the TCEQ in October 2018 concerning a previous business that operated at the Site (Blue Star Recycling). The TCEQ Central Registry noted the "complainant alleges there are two large piles of roofing shingles and is unsure if the property has the required authorization to operate. The complainant also alleged that the operator is stockpiling shingles without removing the materials and stockpiling material at two locations." An investigation was conducted in November 2018. The TCEQ issued a Notice of Enforcement (NOE) on March 11, 2019. The violations included:

- Failure to have a fire prevention and suppression plan and failure to make that plan available to the local fire prevention authority. Failure to report any updates or changes to information contained in the Facility's site report within 90 days of the effective date of the change.
- o Failure to maintain adequate cost closure estimates for the maximum inventories of all processed and unprocessed combustible materials stored outdoors.

According to the regulatory database, an NOV was issued by the TCEQ on June 28, 2019 for "failure to obtain a Permit by Rule (PBR)" and for "failure to keep asphalt-laden dust from leaving their property." The database also stated that "the entity forfeited existence with the Secretary of State" and is no longer operating. An additional complaint was received in May 2020, regarding "the spreading of asphalt shingles near the creek on the property." An investigation was conducted in June 2020 and no Notice of Violation (NOV) or NOE was issued.

The City of Dallas was authorized to access the Site on December 11, 2020 through a Final Agreed Judgment. Following this, the City completed remedial planning and began site preparation efforts on December 14, 2020 when formal control of the Site was granted by the property owner. As part of the approved efforts to remove staged shingle material and related debris, Modern was asked to complete due diligence in the form of a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) and subsequent Phase II Site Investigation. Above-grade shingle material was removed between December 2020 and February 2021 with additional subsurface material (e.g., shingle material mixed with soil) removal between February and May 2021. An estimated 152,000 tons of material was removed from the Site.

After completing the removal of shingles and related material, the City became the property owner. During due diligence efforts it was confirmed the shallow soil at the Site exhibited localized areas with elevated lead concentrations. To prepared for redevelopment of the Site, additional investigation is underway to aid closure in the Texas Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP).
